


Getting Started with Renters Insurance


Simply log into your resident site and click "Purchase policy" on the homepage banner at the top of the homepage.

- Emergency living expenses






Enter Personal Information

Last, choose how you would like to pay. You have the option of paying in monthly installments or upfront annually for a discounted price.




And that's it!
